This notice is addressed to all customers doing business with MAT Dania ApS, MAT DANIA Poland Sp. Z.o.o.

On 11 March 2020 the COVID-19 virus was characterized as a pandemic by WHO and the Danish and Polish parliament have enacted emergency legislation intended to contain the COVID-19 virus spreading further. Further to this, many countries in Europe close borders. However the free movement of goods is not affected by border closures, but it will cause delays and disruptions.

The MAT Dania Group considers the current outbreak of the COVID-19 virus to constitute a force majeure event in respect of the contractual obligations of the MAT Dania Group towards all suppliers, service providers and customers.

The MAT Dania Group remains committed to work together with its suppliers, service providers and customers to mitigate the effects of the COVID-19 virus on current contractual obligations.

Status by 24/3-2020.

Many restrictions implemented by authorities to limit the COVID-19 spread and to safe health of people. The consequence gives turbulences in our Supply Chain and limit our Human Resources availability.

Status by 2/4-2020

We are still running our factories to support your business.

In the recent week we have seen shutdowns and significantly reduced order intake from our customers. Subsequently, we are forced to reduce the capacity. From 6th of April the capacity will be reduced and this means that the foundry will run 1 shift 5 days per week and the Poland factory will continue full operation until further notice.

All employees are sent home under the COVID-19 financial support agreement provided by the Danish government running until 9. June. This means that no employees will be laid off due to COVID 19, and all are ready to support the business with full capacity, when the COVID 19 pandemic is over. The customer support is fully manned in the period.

Status by 28/4-2020

The capacity at MAT Dania foundry was reduced 3 weeks ago and the expected drop in incoming orders and deliveries is now a reality. The reduced capacity will be continued with adjustments; from this week the production is working 3 days a week in 2 shifts. The shipping and receiving of goods are affected as well and will be closed on Thursdays and Fridays.

MAT Dania foundry will be working Monday-Wednesday every week until further notice (week 23 Tuesday-Thursday). The manning in the office will follow the changes in our production, and the main part of employees are working 2 days/week.

The MAT Dania machining plant in Poland is also affected by the reduced activity level, and week 21 the plant will close for all activities including shipping of goods. Deliveries for week 21 will be shipped in week 20.
